
Tata Communications met Lemon Tree Hotels' needs by providing an integrated MPLS VPN service to all existing properties. Phase one of Tata Communications' engagement established MPLS connectivity for Lemon Tree's initial 10 hotels at the MSOC facility in Chennai, with plans to expand service to the additional 11 hotels as needed.

Previously, Lemon Tree Hotels had hosted applications at each individual hotel location. Now, however, the company needed a common platform to host a multi-tier property application and to consolidate data for reporting and analysis. To meet these requirements, Tata Communications established a centralized, robust network architecture solution. Tata Communications helped Lemon Tree scale up quickly and meet its expansion plan requirements, eliminating the need to maintain a large, in-house IT staff, and reducing operational expenditures.

The Managed Hosting and Storage solution is delivered via a dedicated network backbone housed at the Tata Communications data center in Chennai, India.
